

2008 Youth Mission Trip Daily Activities

This year's trip to Belize is shaping up nicely. It looks like we will be completely full (over 30 members), with nearly half being youth. Here is a brief description of what our [TENTATIVE] schedule will look like:

Feb. 29, Friday: We leave Atlanta and arrive in Belize late afternoon. We arrive at the Hospital, get situated and prepare for Sabbath.

March 1, Sabbath: We attend church at one of the local Adventist churches. We spend the afternoon preparing for our evening VBS program in San Antonio. We visit a popular ice cream shop in town.

March 2, Sunday: Construction. VBS in San Antonio.

March 3, Monday: Continue construction and VBS.

March 4, Tuesday: Continue construction and VBS. (Afternoon waterfall trip?)

March 5, Wednesday: We go cave tubing. Woo-hoo!

March 6, Thursday: Construction/ Visit some Mayan Ruins. Caya Twist Ice Cream shop.

March 7, Friday: Short morning of construction. We sail to San Pedro (an island town off the coast of Belize). [Trip to San Pedro is not confirmed yet]. If we don't sail to San Pedro we will visit some Mayan Ruins or a waterfall.

March 8, Sabbath: We attend church in San Pedro. We do a children's program for and help with an evangelistic series. (We will be helping another mission trip from Pennsylvania).

March 9, Sunday: We take a snorkel tour and then return to the mainland and the Hospital. Pack.

March 10, Monday: Fly home!

Summary of trip work and Activities:

Five days of construction

Four nights of VBS

1 night children's program and help for Evangelistic meetings.

1 day excursion cave-tubing

2 trips to Caya Twist Ice Cream

Three days on San Pedro [if confirmed] including one snorkel trip

One trip to Mayan Ruins

One trip to a waterfall? (Bonus activity based on available free-time).
